

2021 Educators Rising Missouri Competition Requirements Outline

All students competing must register to attend the VIRTUAL conference AND complete entry form (link coming) by Mon., Jan. 25 at www.mnea.org/edrising. Conference registration is \$15. Most competitions require a recorded presentation submitted by Feb. 10, along with any other required material. Details in chart below. Competitions are March 10-11, 2021. Schedule will be available Feb. 26. **Detailed competition information, requirements and scoring guides can be accessed on the national Educators Rising website at <https://www.educatorsrising.org>, under Student Resources.** All students entering a state competition must be **paid Active Member of national Educators Rising**. The top five state winners of each competition are eligible to compete at the national level. **Students may enter up to two events.** If a student is a presenter for a chapter competition, that counts as an event entry.

Each chapter entering competitions must also **recruit a judge**. Judges must be able to access materials from the internet before the event and join an online judges training before the conference. Judges and timekeepers complete form at www.surveymonkey.com/r/L9NR3TG by Jan. 25.

Competitions will be divided by grade level: Varsity- grades 11-12, Junior Varsity- grades 9-10, and middle school- grades 7-8. Each chapter can have just two entries in each individual competition at each level- V, JV, MS. If there are fewer than three entries in a grade span, the students will compete at the next highest level. State competitions are closed to spectators this year.

Competitions will have live virtual sessions scheduled on March 10 and March 11. Times will depend on number of entries in each competition, but most will be during the school day. Schedule will be available Feb. 26. **By Jan. 25, each student entering a competition must complete entry form at www.surveymonkey.com/r/XBMTGTX.** For materials to be submitted in advance, label files with this format: LastName.competition.material.2021. Entrants grant Missouri National Education Association, the state coordinator of Educators Rising Missouri, the right to post photos of students for promotional purposes on websites, social media, and printed materials. Entrants may not make any requests about their competition time.
